Owners Lakeside Pool Party:

Dryer Vent Cleaning:

The Board recently discovered that the Dryer Vents installed at Anchor's Point are not up to current code and are a fire risk. We are actively investigating replacing each unit dryer vent to bring each unit up to current code and significantly reduce the risk of fire. After installation, we would be contracting with a certified company to do periodic dryer vent cleaning.

Security Cameras:

Security cameras have been installed to monitor the Parking Lot, Dumpster Corral, and Lakeside Pool. No unit decks or entry areas are included in the view of the cameras and the system has no audio capability.

The security system will not be monitored, but in case of an incident, the system does allow playback for review of the incident.

APCOA Water System:

Our Water System has passed all tests for water sanitation and the water quality is extremely good. The water hardness level is well below the level of our previous water supply.

If you experience a drop in water pressure, it is probably due to your water filter clogging up. Replacing your water filter should resolve this issue. We have been operating our system long enough to have worked through the initial limestone shavings in the system, but some partials may be caught in your filter requiring a water filter replacement.
